

Prüm Treaty

◎ **Prüm Treaty**, was signed on **27th may 2005** in **Germany, Prüm** by the following EU states

- Belgium, Germany, Spain, France, Luxembourg, Netherlands , Austria (7)
- Italy, Slovenia, Portugal, Finland, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania, Slovak Republic (8)

FP, DNA, ballistics, Air marshals, VRD, telephone numbers and communication data, minimum data for identification of persons




Prum statistics

2012

- ◎ 19 MS were operational in DNA data exchange
 - **BG, CZ, DE, EE, ES, FR, CY, LV, LT, LU, HU, NL, AT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, FI**
- ◎ 14 MS were operational in FP data exchange
 - **BG, CZ, DE, EE, ES, FR, CY, LT, LU, HU, NL, AT, SI, SK**

2017

- ◎ 23 MS were operational in DNA data exchange
 - **BE, BG, CZ, DK, DE, EE, ES, FR, CY, LV, LT, LU, HU, MT, NL, AT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, FI, SE**
- ◎ 23 MS were operational in FP data exchange
 - **BE, BG, CZ, DK, DE, EE, ES, FR, CY, LV, LT, LU, HU, MT, NL, AT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, FI, SE**


DNA data exchange

- 4,37 mil. DNA profiles
- 2,78 mil. out going


◎ 2017

- 914 tis. out going (DE not included)




DNA match statistics



DNA Matches




FP data exchange

- 78.065 FP transactions outgoing


◎ 2017

- 207.735 FP transactions outgoing




FP HIT statistics





Prum in practice

April 2012

- Interest in buying precious stones and jewellery
- Meeting in Crown Plaza Hotel Bratislava + Hotel Merkur in Bratislava
- Handing over the money - **3.4 million EUR**
- The stones were genuine, money not
- Investigation begins...




May 2014

- ◎ Request for comparison of fingerprints in PRÜM countries
 - Austria, Germany, France and Spain.
- ◎ Analytical packets of EUROPOL
 - 14 cases with similar “modus operandi”
- ◎ Result:
 - Trace no. DS2LD matches with finger 4-ES,
 - Other traces – NO HIT in databases AT, DE, FR

January 2016

- ◎ Request from Interpol to compare one tenprint card sent from Switzerland
 - **Result = 4 HITs in „jewelry case 2012“**



Summary

- ◎ In 2014 not every country was connected via PRUM
 - **1 HIT in ES**
- ◎ Till 2016 comparison was done via Interpol and Europol channels and from 26 traces 14 HITs were identified.
